A Note On Winter Hikes:

Due to winter weather, many trails can become snowbound and difficult for hiking without snowshoes. While snowshoes are not required for attendance, they are recommended after large snowfalls or on properties with light use. Snowshoes are strongly recommended for hikes at Manistee Headwaters as this property frequently receives large amounts of snow and its trails are infrequently used.
